Increased hyaluronan by naked mole-rat Has2 improves healthspan in mice.

Nature (2023) Vol 621: 196-205.

Naked mole-rats (NMR)s have exceptional longevity. High mass hyaluronan (HMM-HA), in the extracellular matrix of NMRs, has unique protective properties. Transgenic mice overexpressing NMR HHM-HA had reduced inflammation, lower cancer incidence, and longer lifespans, indicating this longevity mechanism in NMR could be exported to other species.
